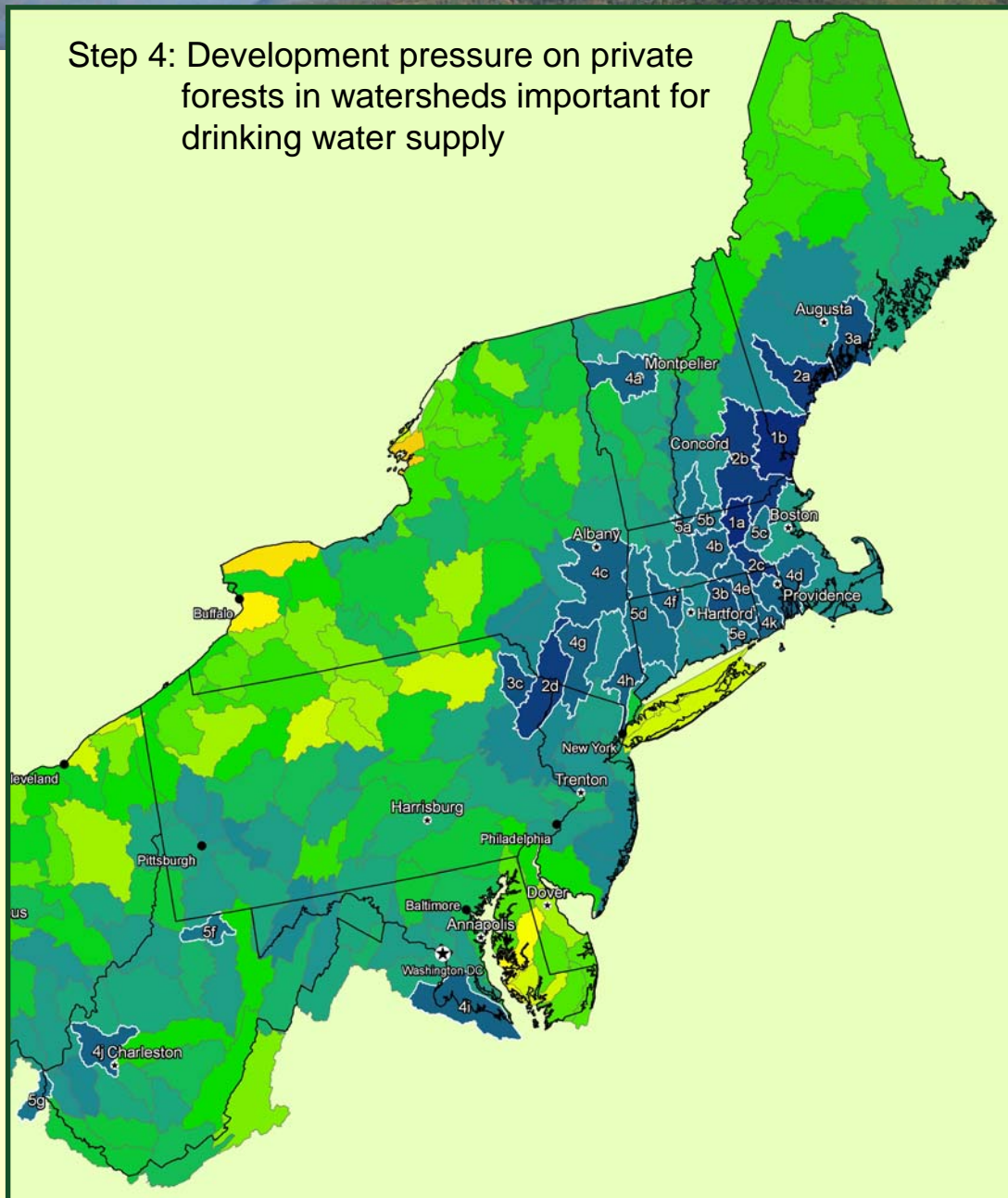


Step 4: Development pressure on private forests in watersheds important for drinking water supply

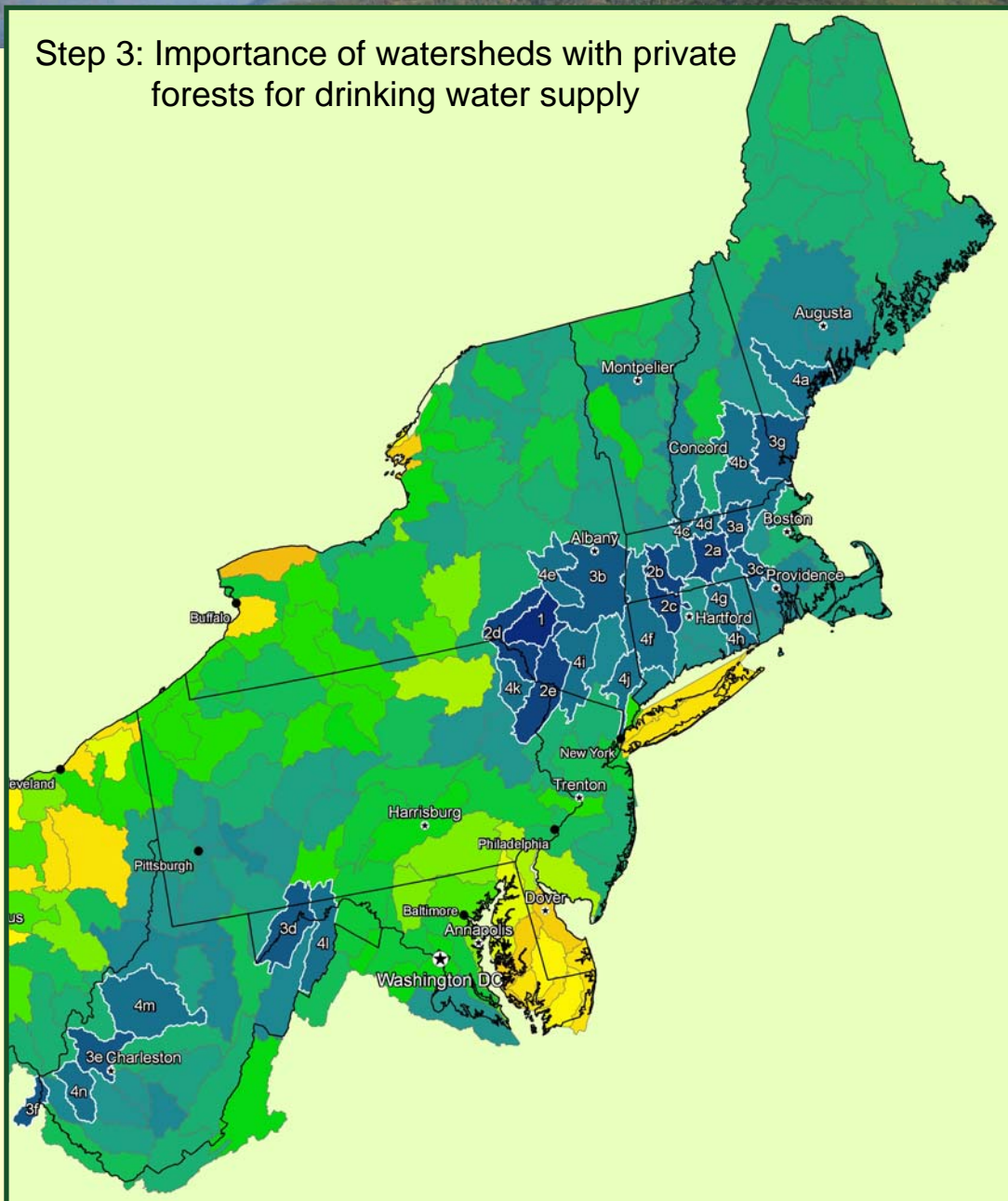
